Registration Notes

- * A maximum of 15 credit hours per semester is allowed unless approved by the MSSW Program Director and the Graduate School.
- * Six elective hours are required and can be taken after completing all generalist requirements. Electives are offered in the spring and summer. In addition, a required course from another concentration or graduate level course may be taken with permission.
- * Students enrolled in a graduate certificate program are required to take 3 or more electives depending on your certificate.
- * Dropped classes will likely impact graduation and financial aid eligibility.
- * Transfer and proficiency credits will most likely result in fewer credit hours in a semester, and this may impact financial aid eligibility.
- * The semester tuition cost is determined by the number of enrolled credit hours. For graduate students, tuition is capped at 9 credit hours each semester.
- * \$250 program fee per semester.
- ** \$250 field fee for each field class.
