- \* Students enrolled in a graduate certificate program are required to take three or more electives depending on your certificate.
- \* Dropped classes will likely impact graduation and financial aid eligibility.
- \* Transfer and proficiency credits will most likely result in fewer credit hours in a semester, and this may impact financial aid eligibility.
