TO STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE MSSW PROGRAM. Advanced elective courses and

field settings combine to provide current students with extensive knowledge and experience within the following areas: Forensic Social Work, Gerontology, School Social Work Licensure, Trauma, and Veterinary Social Work. *Additionally, two dual degrees are offered* in partnership with the University of Tennessee College of Law; an MSSW/JD and an MSSW/MLS.
